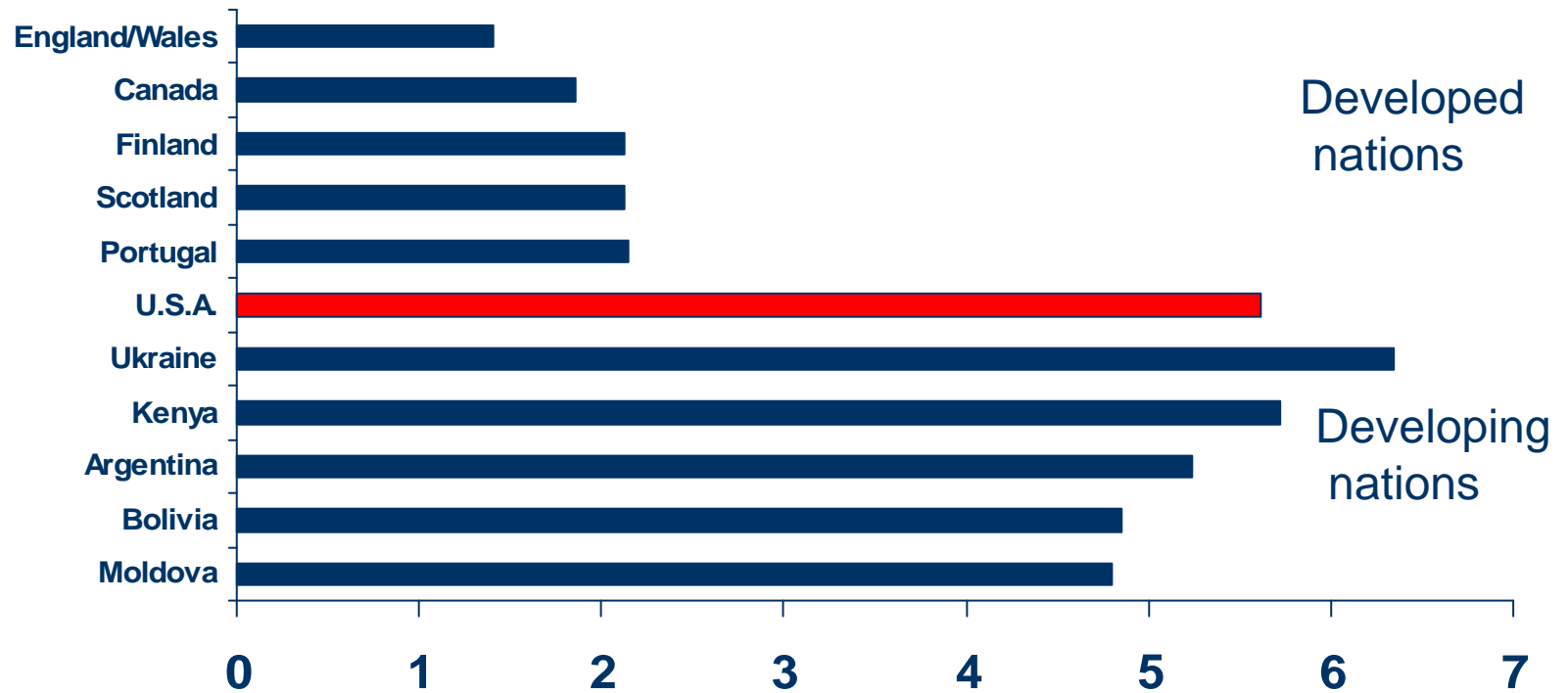

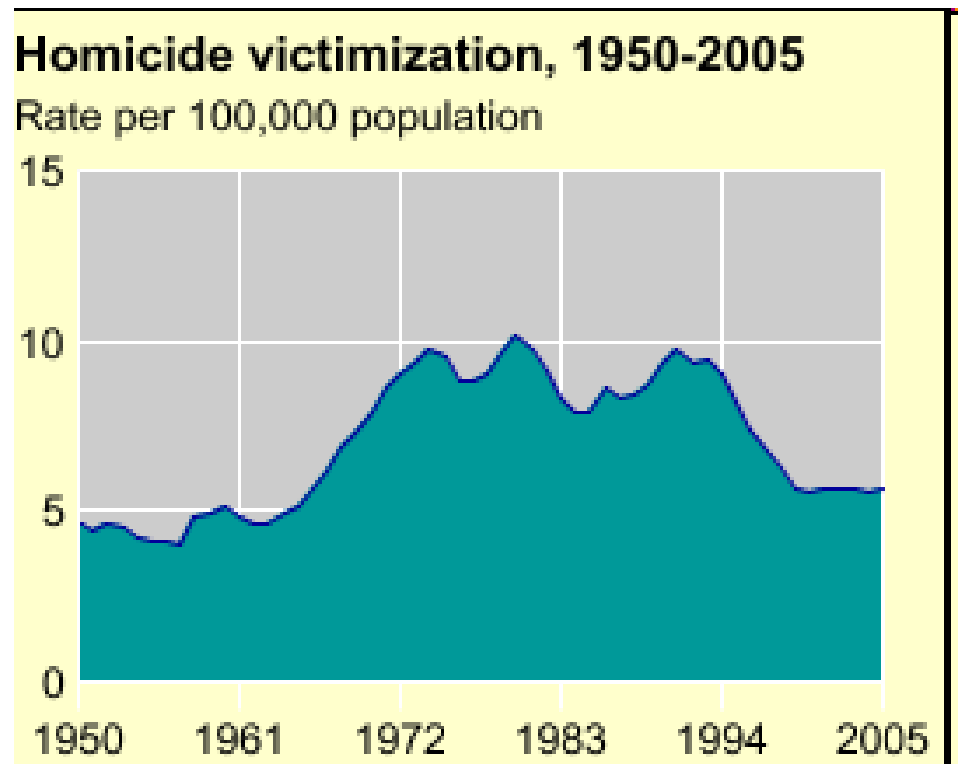
2006 Homicides per 100,000 U.S.A. and selected nations

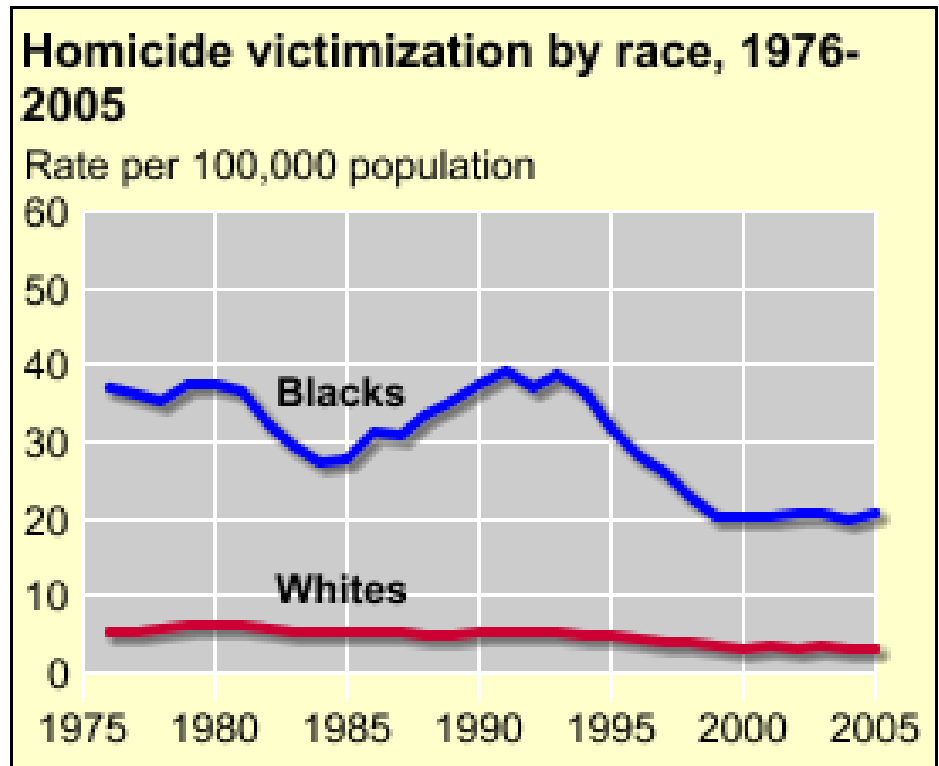
U.S.A. homicide trend

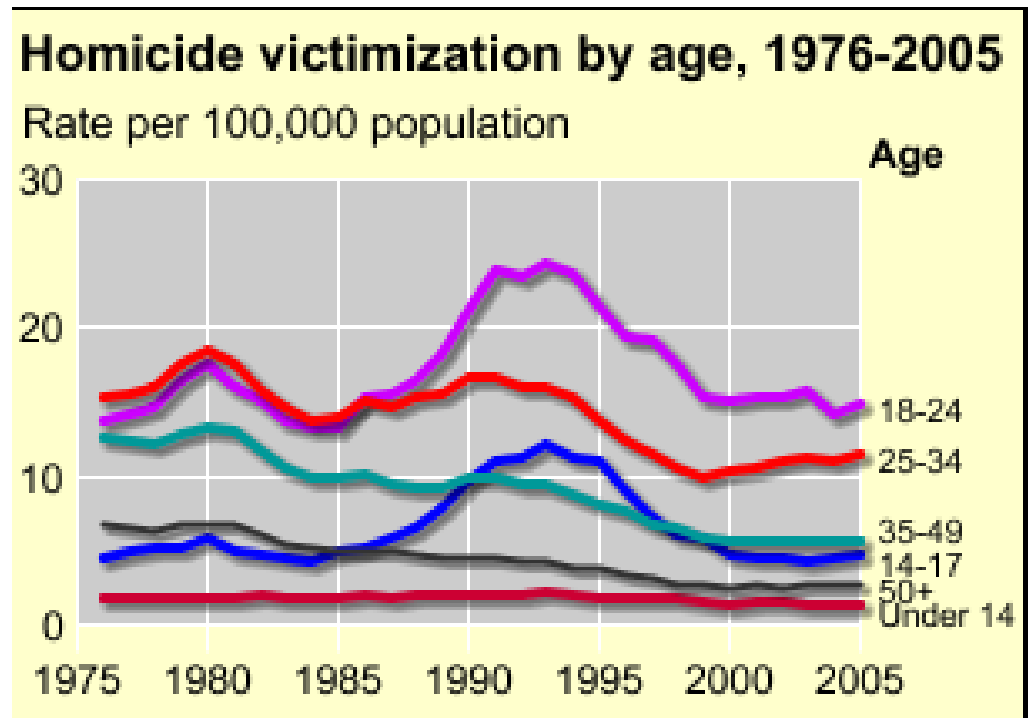
U.S.A. homicides by race

U.S.A. homicide by age

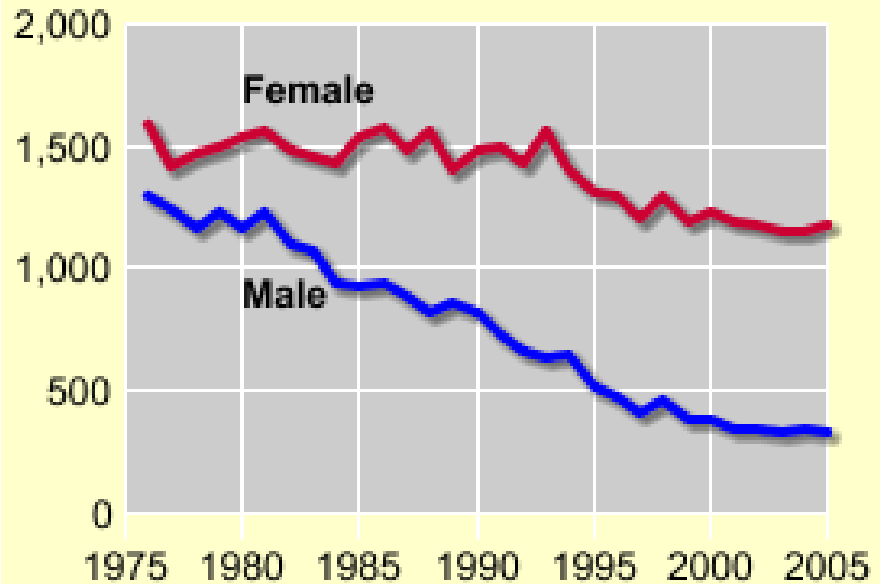

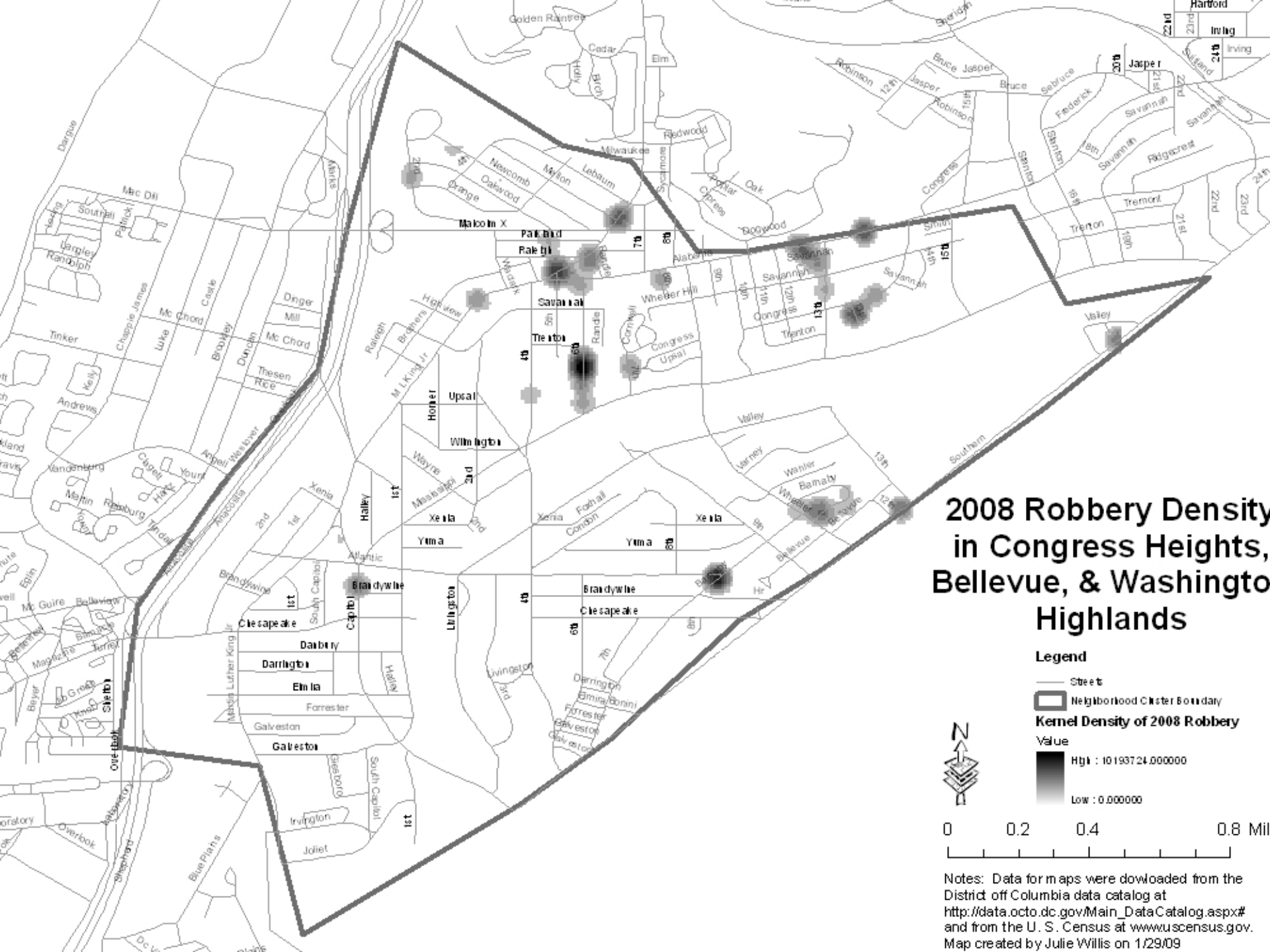
U.S.A. intimate homicides by gender

Number of victims



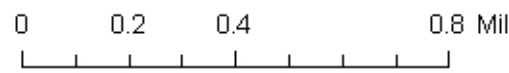
