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
What is Cyberbullying?

"Willful and repeated harm inflicted through the use of computers, cell phones, or other electronic devices" (Hinduja & Patchin, 2015)

"Bullying and harassment, most often by peers, are the most frequent threat that minors face, both online and off..." (Berkman Center's ISTTF Force, 2009)


Lifetime Cyberbullying Victimization Rates

Ten Different Studies 2004-2014





Cyberbullying Victimization Rates Across Peer Reviewed Journal Articles N=51




Lifetime Cyberbullying Offending Rates



Note: low, medium, and high school climate scores are only relative to this particular sample.

On a scale that ranges from 0-3, the average score for each category was: low (1.55), medium (1.71), and high (1.90).


